



AWASI IGUAZÚ - ARGENTINA

Located just 20 minutes from the world's largest waterfalls, Awasi Iguazú is the perfect spot to enjoy the world famous National Park and its surroundings in an amazing privacy and comfort of the lodges, while also taking part in especially crafted excursions that go beyond the falls.



DESTINATION

Situated on the banks of the River Iguazú, the lodge is located just 20 minutes from the Iguazú Falls, one of South America's most iconic destinations. The Iguazu falls are part of the Atlantic Forest, home to thousands of endemic plants and animals (tapirs, capuchin monkeys, puma, toucans, orchids...)

This hotel is suitable for families and couples. Open all year.

Access: 20 min drive from the International Airport of Puerto Iguazú, 35 min drive from Foz do Iguaçu International Airport

ACCOMODATIONS

Built on stilts for minimal environmental impact, the 14 villas are spread throughout the jungle, each positioned for utmost privacy but within easy distance of the main lodge.

With the perfect mix of privacy in the villas, along with the opportunity to socialize at the bar and restaurant in the main lodge, Awasi Iguazú is the perfect place to enjoy the very best of the Misiones Province.

- 13 Villas (100 sqm 1080 sq.ft.): 1 bedroom
- 1 Master Villa (150 sqm- 1610 sq.ft.): 2 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms

Each villa has a spacious living room and outside decking complete with sun loungers and **private plunge pool**. Surrounded by jungle foliage, the stand-alone villas are connected to the main lodge by stone walkways.

ACTIVITIES & SERVICES

All stays are tailor made and all inclusive: from 2 nights' program including all meals with soft and alcoholic beverages, transfers and private outings.

- Full or half day excursions with private guide, english, german, french, spanish speaking
